

Abortion Map of the USA

The map above has 17 states shaded. The population of these states is equal to the number of reported "legal" abortions since 1973. Perhaps this visual perspective helps one to grasp the number of 43+ million...

Our current fertility rate (2 children per woman in child-bearing years) is lower than the replacement level (2.2 children). FACT: Every 24 seconds a baby dies from abortion. That's 1.3 million babies each year, 3600 babies each day, 43+ million babies since Roe v. Wade.

FACT: Just 21 days after conception, the baby's heart is beating, at six weeks, brain waves can be measured; and at eight weeks, the stomach, liver, kidney and brain are functioning and fingerprints have formed.

FACT: At 11 weeks, all of the baby's organs are present and functioning, he/she breathes, swallows, digests, sleeps, dreams, wakes, and has developed all the body parts required to experience pain. From 11 weeks on, all the child needs to become a healthy newborn is nourishment and time.

FACT: Partial-birth abortions which occur in them idle and last stages of pregnancy, mainly on healthy babies of healthy mothers, are not rare.
