RITE OF ELECTION

PRESENTATION OF CATECHUMENS

Catechist:

Bishop Noonan, Easter is drawing near, and so these catechumens, whom I now present to you, are completing their period of preparation. They have found strength in God's grace and support in our community's prayers and example.

Now they ask that after the celebration of the scrutinies, they be allowed to participate in the sacraments of baptism, confirmation, and the eucharist.

The Bishop replies:

Those who are to be chosen in Christ, as the name of your parish is called please stand together with your godparents.

The names of the parishes in attendance will now be called

Catechist:

Bishop Noonan and members of this assembly, these are the catechumens who have entered their names into the Book of the Elect as a symbol of their commitment and desire for baptism. They join with all those throughout the ages who have pledged their futures to Christ.

AFFIRMATION BY THE GODPARENTS AND THE ASSEMBLY

Bishop:

Godparents please place your hand on the shoulder of your catechumen.

God's holy Church wishes to know whether these candidates are sufficiently prepared to be enrolled among the elect for the coming celebration of Easter. And so I speak first of all to you their godparents.

He addresses the godparents:

Have they faithfully listened to God's word proclaimed by the Church?

Godparents:

R They have.

Bishop:

Have they responded to that word and begun to walk in God's presence?

Godparents:

R They have.

Bishop:

Have they shared the company of their Christian brothers and sisters and joined with them in prayer?

Godparents:

R They have.

Bishop:

And now I speak to you, my brothers and sisters in this assembly:

Are you ready to support the testimony expressed about these catechumens and include them in your prayer and affection as we move toward Easter?

All:

R'We are.

INVITATION AND ENROLLMENT OF NAMES

Bishop:

And now, my dear catechumens, I address you. Your own godparents and teachers [and this entire community] have spoken in your favor. The Church in the name of Christ accepts their judgment and calls you to the Easter sacraments.

Since you have already heard the call of Christ, you must now express your response to that call clearly and in the presence of the whole Church.

Therefore, do you wish to enter fully into the life of the Church through the sacraments of baptism, confirmation, and the eucharist?

Catechumens:

R'We do.

Bishop:


Then offer your names for enrollment.

If there are a great many candidates, the enrollment may simply consist in the presentation of a list of the names to the Bishop.

The Bishop stands in front of the altar as each of the catechists holding the book of the elect opened toward the Bishop approaches. The catechumens/godparents follow the catechist with the book for each parish.

The Bishop makes a large gesture of blessing over the names contained in the book. As each book is blessed the catechist moves to a position on the steps holding the books opened toward the assembly. The Bishop will greet each catechumen at this time.

After all books have been presented and the Bishop has greeted the catechumens, the Bishop continues:

ACT OF ADMISSION AND ENROLLMENT OF NAMES

Bishop:

My dear catechumens, I now declare you to be members of the elect, to be initiated into the sacred mysteries at the next Easter Vigil.

Candidates:

R Thanks be to God.

Music begins immediately after "Thanks be to God."

Bishop addresses the elect:

My dear elect, God is always faithful to those he calls: now it is your duty, as it is ours, both to be faithful to him in return and to strive courageously to reach the fullness of truth, which your election opens up before you.

Bishop addresses the godparents:

Godparents, you have spoken in favor of these catechumens: accept them now as chosen in the Lord and continue to sustain them through your loving care and example, until they come to share in the sacraments of God's life.

INTERCESSIONS FOR THE ELECT

Bishop addresses the entire assembly:

My brothers and sisters, in beginning this period of Lent, we look forward to celebrating at Easter the life-giving mysteries of our Lord's suffering, death, and resurrection. These elect, whom we bring with us to the Easter sacraments, will look to us for an example of Christian renewal. Let us pray to the Lord for them and for ourselves, that we may be renewed by one another's efforts and together come to share the joys of Easter.
