May 10 – 24: Plumbing, fixtures, doors, painting, windows, electric, stucco. *Could choose one or both weeks*June 7-14: Finishing, painting, electrical, plumbing

June 14 – 21: Finishing, painting, electrical, plumbing

There will be orientation meetings scheduled in order for missioners to meet their teams and prepare for the trip.

- Purchase your airline tickets

- Make sure your Passport is current
- Attend an orientation meeting (date/time TBA)
- Pack your bags and get ready to go!
- Pray throughout your preparation: for yourself, your teammates, and all you are called to serve
