Building a High School Residence

The Diocese of Orlando Mission Office needs your help on construction missions in our sister diocese: San Juan de la Maguana in the Dominican Republic.

This year, our focus is building a future for education programs by constructing a **high school residence** in the town of Azua. Upon its completion, this residence will house **72 students**, offering them an opportunity to receive high school education at a quality Catholic school.

We need people with various skills to help us throughout the spring/summer of 2014. The dates and projects are listed below. Please contact us as soon as possible to register for one or more of these weeks.

Dates of 2014 Construction Missions

February 15 – 22: concrete work, foundation, plumbing

March 29 – April 12: masonry, room framing - *could choose one or both weeks*

May 10 – 24: Plumbing, fixtures, doors, painting, windows, electric, stucco. *Could choose one or both weeks*

June 7-14: Finishing, painting, electrical, plumbing

June 14 – 21: Finishing, painting, electrical, plumbing

There will be orientation meetings scheduled in order for missionaries to meet their teams and prepare for the trip.

How to apply:

- Visit our website or contact us for an application and to sign-up for fingerprinting/background check.
- Fill out the application and mail in with your \$150 deposit to hold your spot. (The total cost of the mission is \$750, which must be paid, in full, prior to your departure)
- Follow the steps for the FBI background check process (found on our website)
- Review the Mission Trip Info Booklet (available online) and contact us with any questions
- Purchase your airline tickets (MCO to SDQ – JetBlue flights 1705, 1706)
- Make sure your Passport is current
- Attend an orientation meeting (date/time TBA)
- Pack your bags and get ready to go!
- Pray throughout your preparation: for yourself, your teammates, and all you are called to serve
