



PRISON MINISTRY MEETING

On Saturday, June 25th, the Office of Permanent Deacons was honored to host a gathering of key representatives involved in ministry to the incarcerated in the Diocese of Orlando. Deacon Richard Dodd facilitated the meeting. The day started with the celebration of Mass with Bishop Noonan at the chancery and continued with powerful presentations and discussion. Highlights included hearing the first-person experience of a woman recently released from prison and how the caring support of Deacon Dodd allowed her to quickly overcome hurdles to find a home, car and a job. A key presentation was provided by St. Peter Claver Ministry explaining a well-structured approach to reintegration services, including mentorship for those released in their first year. Honest conversations transpired about the need for more volunteers, better training, materials for catechesis to the incarcerated, and more opportunities to offer Sacraments.
