My Sisters and Brothers in Christ:



ANNUAL FORMS

Why be stressed about submitting annual forms on time? All active deacons are required to submit an annual self-evaluation, pastor's evaluation, and continuing formation summary to the Office of Permanent Deacons no later than June 1st. However, early submissions are accepted! Given your pastor's busy schedules, we recommend you get on his calendar now for a meeting to get his pastor's evaluation.




MARCH 24-26, 2023, DEACON MIKE AND MARY FRANCES BERSTENE, "CONFIGURED AS THE ICON OF CHRIST"

The Sacred Order of Deacons is permanently restored as a "living icon of Christ the Servant within the Church." The lives of the deacon and his wife are profoundly transformed by the diaconate and in their respective calls they become living icons of Christ the Servant. This retreat explores the spiritual journey through which we become aware of God's presence and the image of Christ that shapes every part of our lives.

We will use an icon of Christ as a focal point that invites us to a deep spiritual reflection on how we see God, how we see ourselves and how that leads us to be a reflection of God's love as living icons.

Deacon Mike and Mary Frances Berstene have been married for 51 years. Mike was ordained in 1993 and served as the director of deacons for the Diocese of Norwich Connecticut. 



FORMATION MENTORS

Thank you to those who have already indicated their willingness to be added to the mentor list for deacon candidates in formation. We will offer the mentor orientation webinar later this spring. For those of you still contemplating this opportunity, every candidate for diaconal formation is required to have a deacon mentor to walk with them during their last three years of formation, as well as their first year after Ordination. We need experienced deacons who can offer these men 2-3 hours of their time each month to accompany them on this journey. The process involves meeting with the candidate and, ideally, his wife each month to discuss the growth and challenges during formation. Each mentor is required to complete a brief appraisal each month to submit to the Formation Director. 
THEOLOGICAL AND PRACTICAL COURSES TAUGHT BY QUALIFIED FACULTY
