

APPLICATIONS FOR NEXT DEACON FORMATION COHORT BEING SENT

As of December 1st, the application window for men pursuing a potential vocation to the Permanent Diaconate is open. Emails have been sent to pastors of men who either attended a Discernment Night or who have reached out directly to our office. These emails list the names of the men from that pastor's parish, who must reply to our office requesting applications be sent to the men whose application they wish to support.

If you know a man who has expressed interest in the Diaconate from your parish, you can assist this process by checking with your pastor to see if he has received the email and had responded to it. Only the pastor can request the application on behalf of the interested man. The deadline for the return of all completed applications to the Office of the Permanent Diaconate is March 1, 2022.

DEACON CLEARANCE REMINDER

Just a reminder to our "inactive" deacons, you MUST maintain your clearances and safe environment certification every five years. We provide at least a 60-day notice of when your clearances will expire. Per our policy, you no longer must complete annual forms, however, you need to maintain your background checks and safe environment certification to retain active faculties.

CONTINUING FORMATION

Theology Roundtable: The Spiritual Life of the Deacon

When speaking on spirituality and the needs of the Church, Pope Francis explained that, "Without prolonged moments of adoration, of prayerful encounter with the word, of sincere conversation with the Lord, our work easily becomes meaningless; we lose energy as a result of weariness and difficulties, and our fervor dies out. The Church urgently needs the deep breath of prayer, and to my great joy groups devoted to prayer and intercession, the prayerful reading of God's word and the perpetual adoration of the Eucharist are growing at every level of ecclesial life" (Evangelli Gaudium, 262).

What does that mean for deacons and deacon candidates? How does the spiritual serve as the foundation for the daily life of the diaconate in service to the Church?

Join Deacon Scott Conway and Dr. Daniel Lloyd to discuss spirituality as the soil of fruitful ministry.

Deacon Scott Conway is the superintendent of schools for the Diocese of St Augustine. He has an undergraduate degree in philosophy and master's in education from St. John's University. Dr. Daniel Lloyd is Associate Professor of Theology at Saint Leo University. Dr. Lloyd earned his MTS from Weston Jesuit School of Theology and his PhD from Marquette University. His focus is Church history, Trinitarian theology, and Christology.


