CONTINUING FORMATION SURVEY

Thank you to the 72 men responded to our brief survey regarding continuing formation. The three highest areas of interest were: 1. Homiletics; 2. Canon Law and the Sacraments; and 3. Presiding at the Rites of the Church for a Deacon.


Regarding length of the class, the vast majority preferred a half-day workshop or less (1-2 hours). More than 50% of respondents prefer an in-person class.

As a result of your feedback, here are the next steps. We will plan a series of in-person workshops that also be recorded for those who cannot attend. Over the next few weeks, we will solidify the schedule for the first few offerings set to begin in early 2022. We have already begun conversations with Father David Scotchie for homiletics, the Tribunal for Canon Law, and the Office of Liturgy for the Liturgical Rites. DEACON CLEARANCE REMINDER

Just a reminder to our "inactive" Deacons, you MUST maintain your clearances and safe environment training every 5 years. We provide at least a 60-day notice before your clearances expire. Per our policy, you no longer need to complete annual forms, however, you must maintain your background checks and Safe Environment Certification to retain active faculties.
