Recently we have become aware of some deacons modifying the design of the diocesan stole. Some deacons have chosen to have their stoles recreated to use the 'bent elbow' design instead of the 'straight line' cut with which they were created. Please note that the straight-line cut is not to be changed. This stole was created to be a unifying standard among our deacons when we gather in community. Please do not 'individualize' this unifying symbol.
