POPE FRANCIS ANNOUNCES YEAR OF JUBILEE IN 2025: "PILGRIMS OF HOPE"

In a letter addressed to President of the Pontifical Council for the Promotion of the New Evangelization, Archbishop Rino Fisichella, Pope Francis noted "the Jubilee has always been an event of great spiritual, ecclesial, and social significance in the life of the Church." He recalled that ever since the year 1300, which marked the first Holy Year, "God's holy and faithful people has experienced this celebration as a special gift of grace, characterized by the forgiveness of sins and in particular by the indulgence, which is a full expression of the mercy of God."

Considering the recent COVID-19 pandemic, which left no country unscathed, Pope Francis writes that he has chosen the motto "Pilgrims of Hope," for the Jubilee. He explained this will indeed be the case if we are capable of "recovering a sense of universal fraternity and refuse to turn a blind eye to the tragedy of rampant poverty that prevents millions of men, women, young people and children from living in a manner worthy of our human dignity.
