



LITURGY

It has come to our attention that there are deacons who are teaching, encouraging, and coaching parishioners (young and old alike) that their personal liturgical practices are the only acceptable norms for liturgical dress, posture, and how to receive communion. To note just a few:

- Chapel Vails: are an acceptable option for women, not a requirement.
- Kneeling to receive communion is an option, not to be encouraged, especially for those who struggle to get back up.
- Receiving communion on the tongue is an acceptable option, not a requirement. (GIRM, Norms for the Distribution of Holy Communion Under Both Kinds, 41)

Catholics need to be properly disposed to receive Communion. Canon Law outlines some ground rules as to how to determine whether we are properly disposed. In general, Canon Law is strongly prejudiced toward giving someone Holy Communion.

We are charged with the great care of souls with our brother priests and the Bishop. Please use due care in fulfilling this responsibility. 
