
Father González was ordained May 23, 1998, at St. James Cathedral, Orlando where he currently serves as rector. He has served as parochial vicar, then pastor of St. John Vianney Parish, Orlando, headed the Spanish TV Mass ministry, served as spiritual director of the Spanish Cursillo movement, and was the vocations director for the Diocese from 2004-2011. He was also an active radio host on Radio Paz and on Buena Nueva FM. In early October of 2016, Bishop John Noonan named him Rector/Administrator of St. James Cathedral Parish. In addition to his parish duties, Father González is the diocesan and national spiritual advisor to the Council of Catholic Women. He serves on the board of directors of Bishop Grady Villas, a residential community and outreach for adults with disabilities. He also serves as vicar of clergy, member of the Diocese of Orlando Priests' Personnel Board, and member of the Diocese of Orlando Presbyteral Council.

We always look forward to hearing the bishop's thoughts and challenges for our order, and we will recognize service awards for our diaconate community. As with the Priests' Convocation, every active deacon in the Diocese of Orlando is expected to attend unless previous authorization for an excused absence is received from the Office of Permanent Deacons.

On Friday night we will offer an evening social event from 6-9 p.m. at Annunciation. This is a time to relax and reconnect in an informal setting with brother deacons and their wives. Please note there is a second link below to register for the social.

#### RESPONSIBILITIES OF

### AN INSTITUTED ACOLYTE

On Saturday, October 4<sup>th</sup>, the nine men in Cohort 2026 will be instituted as Acolytes, the last of the rites prior to their planned Ordination as Permanent Deacons in June 2026. During the eight months prior to Ordination, they are expected to serve as instituted acolytes at Masses at their parishes to assist them in their liturgical training. Per the standards established by the Diocese of Orlando, here is a list of the functions that an instituted acolyte should serve at Mass.

In the Ordinary Form of the Roman Rite for the celebration of Mass, acolytes may perform the following duties (preferred options for the Diocese of Orlando are in italics):

- Entrance: Carry the processional cross or candles at the front of the entrance procession. Others may carry incense and a thurible. (May also be entrusted with holding the Roman Missal during the prayers delivered from the Presiders Chair.)
- Liturgy of the Word: If it is a regional habit, candles and/or incense can be carried in procession to the ambo or lectern for the proclamation of the Gospel.
- Offertory: When the priest receives the gifts, acolytes may assist him by carrying them.
- Preparation of the chalice:
  - Presents the cruets of water and wine for the deacon or priest to pour in the chalice
  - An acolyte administers the water to the priest as he ritually washes his hands.
- Liturgy of the Eucharist:
  - Acolytes ring the altar bell at the elevations of the species. (Or may be asked to incense the Body and Blood of Christ at the Elevation.)
  - He is a permanent Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.
  - He may purify the communion vessels used during Mass. (Note: acolytes instituted by the bishop are the only ones who may purify vessels other than the priest or deacon.)
- **Recessional:** When the priest and the acolytes leave the altar, again the processional cross and candles are carried.


