With 27 years of priestly ministry, he exercises comprehensive pastoral and faith leadership for his parish community. Additionally, he has taught for several years in the Permanent Diaconate Formation Program and for one year at the Josephinum Institute.

REMINDERS FOR THE OFFICE OF WORSHIP

LITURGY ANNOUNCEMENTS

- The Dicastery for Divine Worship and Discipline of the Sacraments has approved the English translation of the Liturgy of the Hours!
- On November 10, Archbishop Broglio signed a **Decree of Publication** with the expectation that Volume II Lent and Easter will be the first volume to go into production and will be available by Ash Wednesday 2027.
- Bishop Steven Lopes, current chair of the BCDW, announced the name of the English liturgical Bible as "Catholic American Bible" (to be available Ash Wed 2027). You will recall that this was approved by the Bishops previously as the translation of the Bible which will be used in liturgy, including the Lectionary for Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours as well as a printed Bible for the USA. During the translation process it had been referred to by some as the "revised, revised New American Bible."
- The USCCB Administrative Committee approved the *Biblia de la Iglesia en America* (to be available Ash Wed 2026). This will impact the development of the Leccionario for the USA.






