



The Order of Deacons is to be a driving force for the Church's service or diakonia of the local Christian community, a sign or sacrament of the Lord Christ himself, who "came not to be served but to serve." (*Mt 20:28*) Deacons are ordained to be ministers of Word, Liturgy, and Charity. He must be willing to undertake each in some way. (*National Directory for the Formation Ministry & Life of Permanent Deacons in the U. S.*)

The undersigned acknowledge that the Permanent Deacon is an ordained minister of the Roman Catholic Church who has received the Sacrament of Holy Orders. He is thus empowered by the grace of the Sacrament to carry out all aspects of Diaconal ministry.
